Comments: The blue portion of this tourmaline contains copper and manganese and may be called "paraiba tourmaline" in the trade. The name "paraiba" comes from the Brazilian locality where this gem was first mined, however today it may come from several localities.

The purple portion of this tourmaline is not consistent with what is called "paraiba tourmaline" in the trade. Any statement on geographic origin is an expert opinion based on a collection of observations and analytical data.
